

Pilot Case Study Summary

Context

Catalyst Ed partners with schools and districts to pilot the AI Literacy for Educators certificate. Pilots are designed around teacher dignity, instructional rigor, and measurable classroom transfer — not vendor metrics.

Pilot Structure

Cohorts of 10–30 educators complete a 7.5-hour accredited pathway over four to six weeks. Each module produces a classroom-ready artifact reviewed by a Catalyst-trained facilitator. Accreditation is delivered through Sonoma State Extended Education.

What We Measure

Completion rate, artifact quality (rubric-scored), educator-reported instructional shifts, and administrator-observed classroom transfer. We do not collect student-identifiable data.

Availability of Detailed Findings

Detailed pilot results are released to participating districts under a data-use agreement. Aggregate findings from completed cohorts are available on request.
